

Hadracha Program (High School Teaching Assistants)

***Hadracha* Program: Sunday (Bellevue/Seattle), Wednesday (Bellevue), Thursday (Seattle).**

Students in 9-12th grade have the opportunity to work as *madrichim*, “guides”, in the Bridge Family Religion School. Working as a Madrich(a) is a paid work position at Temple. While *madrichim* do aid teachers in simple tasks, their responsibilities go beyond the administrative duties suggested by the term “teachers’ aides.”

As *madrichim*, they guide younger students toward a positive Religion School experience by demonstrating their involvement, their skills at collaboration, and their initiative.

8th graders can apply to be a madrich/a on Wednesday and Thursday for volunteer hours.

Within the program we offer different tracks that allow teens to specialize in various aspects of the school: Music/Songleading, Art, Technology, and Classroom. The program structure creates a unique and meaningful way for teens to have a spiritual connection, education component, and work experience.
