- Each Temple member who is at least 18 years old and in good standing & in attendance can hold (2) proxy votes
- Proxy Forms:
 - Must specify name of appointed proxy
 - Must be dated
 - Must print names legibly
 - Must have your signature
 - Member # will be added by Temple office
 - Returned to Temple at or prior to the meeting/vote

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROXY VOTING:

Temple's By-Laws allow you to cast your vote and be counted by proxy. (See By-laws, Article IV, Sections 4 and 5 at [http://templedehirschsina.org/about-us/board-of-directors/.](http://templedehirschsina.org/about-us/board-of-directors/)) In order to maintain the integrity of the congregational approval process, certain limitations and procedures were implemented along with the proxy voting provision. Your vote is important and, if you want it to count, and cannot be at the meeting where a vote is taking place, you may use the proxy to do so, provided the proxy is in compliance with the simple guidelines which were put in place. This shall serve as a simple guide to proxy voting at TDHS.

- For a proxy vote to be valid it must be in writing.
- Congregant must designate another TDHS member in good standing who will personally be present at the meeting where the vote is to take place as their proxy and write that person's name on the proxy form.
- Note - no member can hold more than two proxies. A valid proxy also counts toward satisfying the quorum requirement for the meeting.
- You may designate a proxy by writing the name of a member in good standing where indicated. However, one person cannot hold more than two proxies. If you prefer to leave the proxy blank, our bylaws provide that the person authorized to tabulate votes for Temple will assign the proxy to a member in good standing who is in attendance. Your proxy may, but is not required to, specify a limitation on the proxy or direct how to vote on a specific matter.
- You must print your name and sign your proxy.

Return your proxy to the Temple office in person, by mail, by e-mail (scanned proxy form) to jphillips@tdhs-nw.org, or by fax at 206.324.6772, all to the attention of Jennifer Phillips. It must be received prior to the designated meeting time. Alternatively, your designated proxy may bring your proxy form to the meeting.
