Terramation: An Option for Burial to Explore



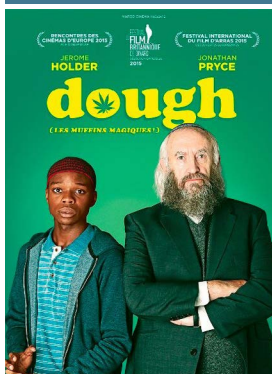
