3rd Grade Hebrew Program 5787

Welcome to the first year of “official” Hebrew school. Our goal for this first year of Hebrew school is to create a strong foundational experience. By 3rd grade your child/ren will have been exposed to the Hebrew language through participating in T’fillah, Hebrew through Movement (modern Hebrew) on Sunday mornings, and Jewish Life Vocabulary - Hebrew words that are integrated into our weekly program (such as: Shabbat, Mitzvah, Torah).

Hebrew is required for all students in 3rd – 6th grade.

Main Goal

Our number one goal in our Hebrew program is to create positive associations with the Hebrew language as the Hebrew learning experience is deeply tied into the creation of Jewish identity.

“Intro to Hebrew”

3rd grade curriculum focuses on foundational basics that contribute to successful decoding such as exposure to the sounds of Hebrew through Hebrew through Movement, songs, videos, T’fillah (prayer) and Jewish Life Vocabulary (JLV). Hebrew is an essential part of creating a positive Jewish identity and necessitates conversations about why we learn Hebrew and why we pray as well as the meaning behind the prayers and their foundation in Torah. Students will have a chance to share their thoughts and participate in conversations about God and the purpose of prayer. Students will also begin recognizing letters as part of their surroundings.

3rd graders will register for one of the three “*Midweek Hebrew*” dates/times for their weekly Hebrew classes. Participation in 3rd grade Hebrew is a requirement as part of our B’nai Mitzvah track.

Details:

This 1.5 hr. program will offer the following opportunities for learning/connection:

- T’fillah (prayer service)
- Community building time/games
- 3rd grade specific content and interactive Hebrew focused activities often with Rabbinic support (God and prayer activities)
- Incorporating Jewish Life Vocabulary and Hebrew Through Movement in the classroom
