### 2026-2027 Registration Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

#### REGISTRATION PROCESS:

**Q: What are the steps for registration this year?**

**To start enrollment if you are a **Returning Member****

**A:** You will need to log in to ShulCloud and [start](#) the process.

**To start enrollment if you are a **New Member****

**A:** To start enrollment, [Click here to START REGISTRATION and enter your email address to set your password.](#) **please enter your email address and click “Forgot Password”**. This will direct you to check your email for a link to reset your password. We know you haven’t used it before, and this is the best way to access the account we have created for your email address on file.

**Q: How do I find out more about what is taught at the various grade levels for this year?**

**Q: Why do you ask about my child’s learning or behavioral needs?**

**A:** Our goal is to create a conducive learning environment for all students. Information about any accommodations or modifications your child may be receiving in school, per an IEP or 504 plan, and any anecdotal suggestions, helps our teachers prepare lessons accessible to all students. We strive to create supportive environments in each of our classrooms that honor each student’s individual strengths. This information will be kept confidential between the site coordinator and the teacher.

**Q: What is “Tiyulim”?**

**A:** This is a program for 7<sup>th</sup> grade ONLY. It is field trip based, designed to help build Jewish connections for our students outside the synagogue. It creates a bridge between TDHS and the larger world, giving our students a chance to interact with

**Q: When will I find out which class my child has been assigned to?**

**A:** Families will be contacted by their child’s teacher in September in a welcome email.

**Q: I believe I completed the BFRS registration process successfully, but have not received a confirmation email?**

**Q: Why do I need to register my child for Hebrew School in addition to Religion School?**

**A:** If your child is in 3rd, 4th, 5th or 6th grade – your child is required to enroll in Hebrew School in order to begin their B’nai Mitzvah preparations. If your child has been diagnosed with dyslexia, dyscalcula, etc..please connect with Jessie so we can support your child’s individual needs.

**Q: Will I be guaranteed my spot on the day I choose for Hebrew School?**

**A:** Based on previous years, students will likely get their preferred Hebrew school days. However, there are some days in which classes fill quickly, and other days in which too few students enroll to be able to keep the class open. Therefore, we do encourage you to register early to secure your preferred choice!

**Q: My child is fluent in Hebrew, are they still required to attend Hebrew School?**

**A:** Please complete your registration *including* Hebrew school and reach out to Jessie Stott ([jstott@tdhs-nw.org](mailto:jstott@tdhs-nw.org)) to apply for a waiver. (You will be refunded for Hebrew school if the waiver is approved). However, being fluent in spoken modern Hebrew is not the same as prayer fluency. We can provide an individualized approach.

**Q: My child attends Jewish Day School. Do I still need to register for Hebrew school?**

**A:** Please complete your registration including Hebrew school and please contact the Director of Education, Stacey Delcau ([sdeclau@tdhs-nw.org](mailto:sdeclau@tdhs-nw.org)).

**Q: My child will likely need support learning Hebrew, in addition to online or in-person learning. How can we get that tutorial support?**

**A:** In addition to practice materials your students' teachers can provide, we also have a list of approved tutors. Please reach out to Jessie Stott ([jstott@tdhs-nw.org](mailto:jstott@tdhs-nw.org)) for more information.

**Q: If our schedule changes, may we change the day we attend Hebrew school?**

**A:** Yes! But, as our teachers work hard to build a sense of class community and because teachers progress through the curriculum at different paces, we can only approve **one** change per school year. **Q: What are social/community building options for middle schoolers/high schoolers and how do I register them?**

**A:** There are multiple ways for involvement for all 6-12<sup>th</sup> graders!

**6-8<sup>th</sup> graders:**

- **Social programs for all middle schoolers are called “678 Events.”** These events take place quarterly throughout the year. Registration will be emailed out 3-4 weeks before each event. Come to one or come to all! [Email Robin](#) for more details.

**9-12<sup>th</sup> Graders:**

- **TDSY Tuesday Bellevue** (9-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) is a weekly class for with teen-chosen topics taught by our rabbis and Jessie Stott on a rotational basis. Register your teen during the Sunday School/Hebrew School registration process. Dinner provided. [Email Jessie](#) for more details.
- **TDSY (Temple De Hirsch Sinai Youth) Social Events** (9-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) take place monthly led by our TDSY Intern Board to foster bonds between our teens. Registration will be emailed out 3 weeks before the event takes place. [Email Robin](#) for more details.
- **TDSY Leadership Team** (10-12<sup>th</sup> Grade) is our Intern Board responsible for planning and running our TDSY Events. Applications open in the Spring.
- **Confirmation** (10<sup>th</sup> Grade) is a monthly class for our teens to discuss the Big Questions of Judaism with our rabbis and continue their Jewish journey. The year ends with our teens leading the Confirmation Service on Shavuot. Registration will be emailed out in September. [Email Jessie](#) for more details.

- **Senior Sessions/Graduation** (12<sup>th</sup> Grade) are quarterly events with Rabbi Weiner and Jessie Stott to bring our seniors together and celebrate the end of their youth experience at TDHS. The year ends with a Graduation Service led by our Seniors. Registrations for Senior Sessions are emailed out 3 weeks before each event and Graduation registration is emailed out 6 weeks before the service. [Email Jessie](#) for more details.
